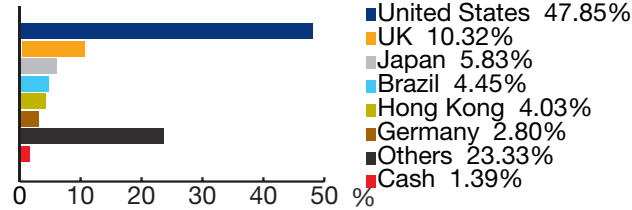

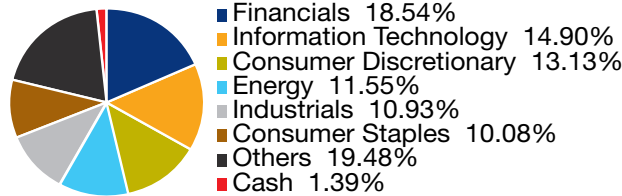

By Country

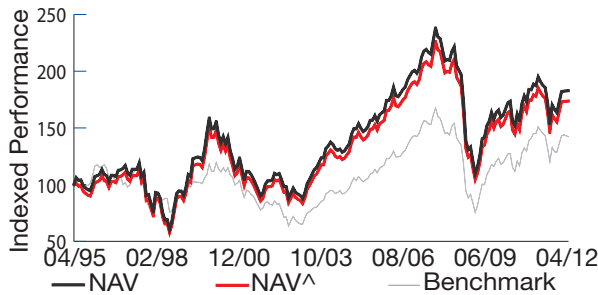


By Sector
